


It basically supports 2 coaxial and 1 optical, but you can optionally select dual AES/EBU considering dCS, I2S of the widely used HDMI standard that has been increasing recently, and MSB Pro ISL that matches MSB technology.

A server built like a reference DAC

At the heart of the N50 is a bold triple-chassis architecture, echoing the layout of state-of-the-art reference DACs. The server section, power supply, and audio circuitry are physically separated, pushing noise isolation to an almost obsessive level. This isn't design for show—it's about preventing even the smallest traces of electrical interference from reaching the digital output stage. The result is a signal that arrives at your DAC cleaner, more stable, and more precise than ever before.

Aurender's long-standing war on jitter is taken several steps further here. The N50 is equipped with an ultra-precision OCXO clock, tightly integrated with FPGA-based real-time control. Timing accuracy is exceptional, and the sense of rhythmic coherence that follows is immediately audible.



By separating the server, power, and audio, Aurender's consistently prioritized measures against noise and jitter are further strengthened.

Connectivity

The N50 is clearly designed to sit at the center of a true reference system. Standard outputs include two coaxial and one optical connection, while advanced users can configure the unit with dual AES/EBU, HDMI-based I²S, or MSB Pro ISL to match the finest DACs on the market. A newly developed noise-isolated USB 2.0 output further expands system flexibility.

Even the network stage reflects Aurender's uncompromising mindset. The galvanically isolated LAN architecture has been dramatically upgraded, with multiple layers of noise suppression designed to keep network contamination far away from the audio signal path. This level of attention to the "invisible" parts of digital playback is exactly why Aurender has earned its reputation.



It also has a new noise-isolated USB 2.0 output. In addition, it is equipped with Aurender's proud ultra-precision OCXO clock, which creates perfect timing and jitter reduction for FPGA real-time control.

Sound

What truly defines the N50, however, is the listening experience. There's no artificial sharpness, no hyped detail, no attempt to impress in the first ten seconds. Instead, the sound unfolds with a sense of effortlessness that draws you in—and keeps you there. Resolution is extraordinary, yet completely natural. The noise floor feels vanishingly low, allowing micro-details and spatial cues to emerge without strain.

Soundstage width and stability are exceptional, but it's the sense of flow and coherence that leaves the deepest impression. Music feels unforced, emotionally intact, and profoundly engaging. You don't listen analytically for long; you simply start revisiting your entire library, rediscovering familiar recordings with renewed excitement.

Paired with a top-tier DAC, the N50 doesn't just complement the system—it unlocks it. The synergy is immediate and unmistakable, delivering the kind of "this is it" moment that defines true reference components.
